The purpose was to spread knowledge and techniques to the professionals and parents of Children with Special Needs.
- UDAI started a new method of sharing and building team spirit by Weekend
 Class and Case Discussion Forum. It is scheduled to take place on Saturdays
 between the Educators & the Therapists to discuss, analyze and take
 necessary measures for the child's progress.

Life Skill Training

"Education Makes You Sufficient

Skills Make You Efficient"

Life Skill or Daily Living Skills is a series of activities of self-dependence & those involving personal care across home, school, work and community like personal hygiene, housekeeping, self-care and getting around the community.

These are the subset of adapted behavior, which includes communication, social and relationship skills that are likely to be harder for someone on the spectrum. Develop practical living skills such as safety, finding information (internet), traveling, home care (housecleaning), monetary skills (reading MRP, counting currency notes), shopping, etc. For the same we train & demonstrate the skills by giving them a hands-on experience.

- ☐ Children were taken for a Metro Ride wherein they were taught to generate tokens, look for the destination, board the metro and other metro rules.
- ☐ Our young adults are frequented to Kotak Mahindra bank for basic understanding about banking transactions.
- ☐ This year two outstation camps were organized and many children joined the same. The first one was to Saat Taal and the second was to Mukteshwar. These kind of camps helps in development of social skills, independent living system and recreational skills.
- □ A Day-cation to Surajgarh Farms, Gurugram was also organized for UDAI Team & Students. Activities like magic show, pottery, camel & bullock cart rides, Burma Bridge, etc. gave a good break to the staff in addition to a great boost in the self-esteem & confidence to the children. It was a great experience for all.

Parents Association Meet

UDAI came up with the concept of Parents Association Meet in the past year. This is a discussion forum for parents of children on spectrum, and is initiated with the purpose of sharing problems, challenges, experiences, solutions they come across in everyday life.

The meet is organized on a regular basis in the school premises with a different theme each time.

This initiative has been appreciated well by the parents and they have become more aware & receptive in terms of acceptance.
