In the coming year the trust remains committed to educate children and to train children and adults to be independent, confident and integrative in a challenging environment.

### **Awareness campaign**

UDAI took initiative to create awareness and sensitize the community towards disability with a particular focus on those who are subject to being inaccessible and excluded. For that, UDAI staff, parents and children organized an Awareness Walk on April 2, 2016 at Dilli Haat, Janakpuri. A dance performance was presented by the staff for the same.

### **Vocational Training**

- ❖ Five of our children successfully completed 18 months course of AIMS Media and entered the second level for which the tenure is 24 months. It gives us immense pleasure and motivation when our children perform well and move forward. This course will help in making them independent for earning a livelihood.
- ❖ Many stalls were laid up during Diwali in different places and we got a commendable response for the products made by our children.
- ❖ Pickles made by the children were liked by everyone and has been the hot selling product for many years now.
- ❖ This year we started new vocational products like chutney and a bakery unit.

### **Daily living skills**

As we aim to work on holistic development of the children, their curriculum is more focused on socialization, independent living, functional academics etc. So in order to achieve that UDAI planned a visit to different places like

- ❖ Banks
- ❖ Metro rides
- ❖ Malls
- ❖ Restaurants- While a visit to a restaurant, our children learnt to use lift, deciding menu & placing order for the food of their choice.
- ❖ This year a new initiative was taken by UDAI in collaboration with AIMS Media where our senior children went to an overnight camp. There were many different activities like Firefox, tunnel crossing, rope climbing, bonfire, etc. This camp was organized to make children independent.
- ❖ Excursions (picnic visit to a park) - A visit to a park for the staff and children was organized where in a lot of activities were done and it was a great time for all of us.

## Workshops and Trainings

A **workshop** is a period of discussion or practical work on a particular subject in which a group of people share their knowledge & experience. Considering the same, we organized a training cum workshop the details of which are under:

- ❖ **Training programme for parents and professionals:** A five days hands on training was organized for parents and professionals. The workshop was planned considering the need of handling the children with special needs. Many professionals and parents showed up for the same and gained a good knowledge in meeting the needs of children.
- ❖ **Workshop at Billabong International School:** Billabong International School situated in Noida, invited the Directors of UDAI for conducting a workshop on “**Classroom strategies for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder**”. This was an interactive workshop in which various tasks were given to the teachers for effective working. Various TLM (Teaching Learning Material) were made by teachers as per the cases given to them. The session was appreciated a lot by the attendees.
- ❖ The **Occupational therapy department** attended/organized a brain gym workshop for parents/professionals. Brain gym is a part of education Kinesiology programme. This helps to develop the visual, auditory, Kinesthetic, Vestibular, Tactile and Proprioceptor senses using movements. Brain gym can be a very effective technique that can improve anti-social behaviour such as bullying, naturally and quickly.
- ❖ AIMS Media conducted a workshop at UDAI in putting up a workstation for children who will be successfully completing the second level of training.



### **Achievements by children**

- ❖ An opportunity was given to our children to perform at Akashvani FM Gold. Two of our children performed and were acknowledged for the same.
