Education goes online:



The effect of the COVID-19 pandemic quickly turned into a global health crisis that evoked an education emergency of an unprecedented scale. During the COVID-19 pandemic, many countries have relied on technology to mitigate learning loss.

While the road to virtual education has been rugged, to find remedies and filling gaps in a seemingly exclusionary education system, we have to recreate instructional programmes to provide familiar learning spaces to work along with parents of our special needs children.



The team of special educators curated the lesson plan for the day and is shared with parents in advance while regular attempts to scout for tasks to undertake at home environment are made. There has been a lot of Trial and error situations where he had to conduct through analysis on various options for online sessions and chose whatever best method suits the need of the child whether it is one on one basis or group sessions. Our team has experimented different solutions and there was no rigidity in the online options adopted. Most of the teaching was done through interesting videos, PowerPoint presentations.

The sessions included interesting parent empowering activities on regular basis which include yoga, music, wellness programmes as well as innovative modules where parents are able to participate in tasks along with their child. Daily telephonic check ins and regular communications by special educators with parents kept the momentum going smoothly. These practices and conversations have inculcated the confidence in parents to manage the child during these testing times.

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on mental health of caregivers. The well-being of parents/caregivers have a direct impact on their ability to care for children with special needs. Adapting to new modes of online learning has been challenging for the students and educators similarly.

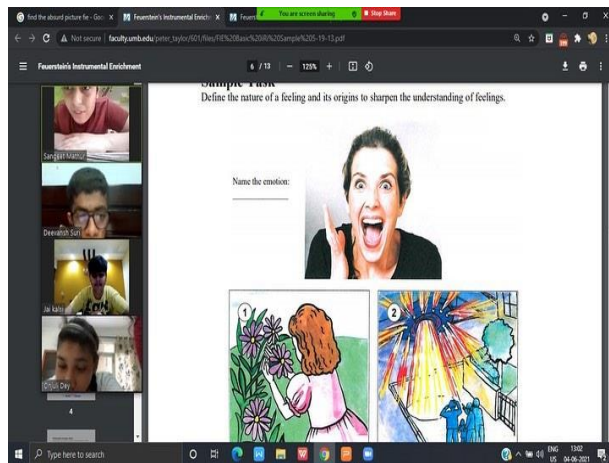
This series of webinars dealt with training on challenges related to work behaviours, independent functioning, occupational skills and application of person`s potential in long term settlement.

To our surprise the most people do not even realize that they have acquainted their minds and bodies with mild or moderate disability levels, according to a source.

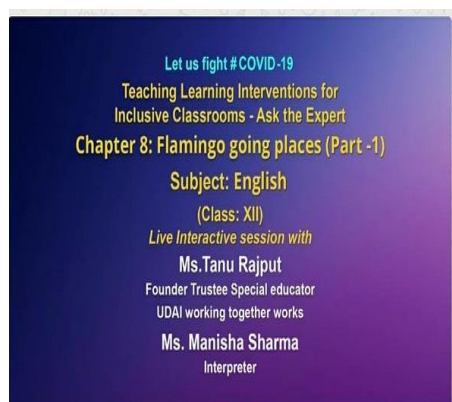

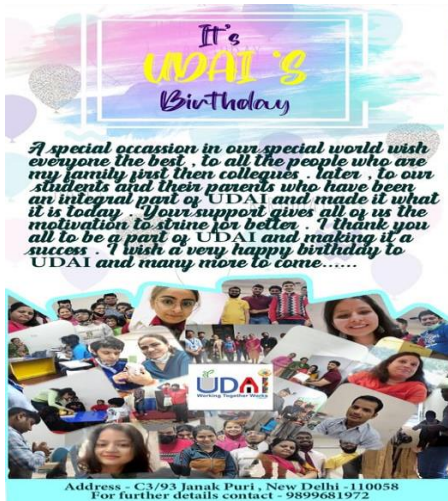
