### **A Successful year.....**

The year 2013-2014 was a landmark year and a milestone for UDAI. With the popularity, immense hard work and team effort of the staff and parents we received a tremendous response from nearby hospitals, doctors etc.

### **Strength increased**

The number of children with disabilities increased from 22 to 25 students. It was certainly a very encouraging response as we entered the year 2014-2015.



### **Expansion of the school premises**

As the strength of the school increased the shortage of space was greatly felt. After lot of consultation and raising funds we were able to manage and take the extended part of the basement.



### **New initiatives**

UDAI organized Dental checkup and visits of a Dietician as part of the school health plan. As children with various disabilities including ASD require constant check in their diet, food hence the need for this camp was suggested by the parents.

### **Setting up of a Speech Therapy Unit**

The need of a speech therapy unit was felt from the very beginning but due to paucity of funds it was difficult to hire a speech therapist initially. Special effort was made to raise funds to provide this facility at UDAI.

Most of the activities and events which was started in the first year continued this year as well but with more preparedness and vision.

## Vocational Training

Pre- vocational training programme was started with young adults having ASD, Intellectually Challenged as part of their curriculum gradually making them learn a skill for future independence.
